- To enhance the resilience of youth against addictive behaviors












Objectives



Service Flow

Training & briefing to MPs & social workers

Referral from NGO / Hotline /Outreach

First Screening conducted by social worker

Body Check-up

Sharing with MPs and social worker to fine tuning the service content

Medical consultation & motivational interview provided by MPs

Follow up counseling services rendered by referring case worker Follow up group activities rendered by the project

Role of the MPs

- Motivate young substance abusers to engage in drug treatment or abstain from drug abuse
- Medical consultation service
- Explain results of the check-up
- Recommend further laboratory tests or make referrals to other treatment and medical services when necessary.
- Provide assistance in sharing sessions for the anti-drug services, anti-drug preventive education or publicity works









Role of TWGHs CROSS Centre

- Collaborate with MPs and NGOs on drug treatment
- Coordinating the body check-up & medical consultation sessions
- Training & supporting for Motivational interviewing
- Monitoring case progress
- Organize group activities for participating youth









Body Check-up Items

A. Items Checked by Project Social Workers before doing lab test

- Weight, Height, Body Fat
- Eye-hand coordination (Purdue Pegboard)
- Memory Test (Rivermead Behavioral Memory Test)









Body Check-up Items (cont

B. Baisc Level of Body Check-up

- Pulse rate
- Blood pressure
- Body mass index
- Urine test
- Blood test
- X-ray chest
- Electrocardiogram

C. Advanced Level of Body Check-up

- Cognitive assessment
- HIV
- Venereal disease
- Hepatitis B
- Stool
- Ultrasound kidneys
- Others


