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
A Multi-disciplinary Approach on Working with Young Drug Abusers

- To develop an exemplary programme for future implementation on regional basis.










Project Particulars

- Target: 300-400 Psychotropic substance abusers
- Age: 10-24 years old
- Territory-wide









Service Flow

Training & briefing to MPs & social workers

Referral from NGO / Hotline /Outreach

Intake Interview conducted by social worker

Body Check-up

Sharing with MPs and social worker to fine tuning the service content

Medical Consultation

Follow up counseling rendered by referring case worker

Follow up group activities rendered by the project

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Use of Motivating Tools

- Assessment tools on early stage of intervention
 - Test of eye-hand coordination (**Purdue Pegboard** Test)
 - Memory test (Rivermead Behavioral Memory Test)
- Body check-up service
 - Lab test
 - Medical consultation
 - Nurse consultation
 - Cognitive assessment











to everyday situations.










Body Check-up Service
