Overall evaluation of the project

- 1. 提升學習自信,予學生發揮潛能的機會,建立 學生反思習慣,啓發學生訂立人生目標,回饋 社會。
 - 25名學生完成『 Drugs Zero! 滅毒先鋒』訓練工作坊
 - 23學生完成外展歷奇訓練。
- 凡參加了Drugs Zero活動的學生都參與過校內及社區內最少一次的社區抗毒教育活動,推廣健康生活訊息。同學均表示透過禁毒工作坊,他們的自信心增加,亦開始為自己訂立人生目標。



Overall evaluation of the project

- 2. 師生互勉,結為成長夥伴。家校合作,促進親子溝通。
- -由於本校的家長都在區外工作,家長的禁毒工作坊未能 成功舉辦。但我們透過Drugs Zero! 社區嘉年華、學校網 頁宣傳、家長日的禁毒短片播放,都能讓家長有機會參與 禁毒活動,了解健康人生的訊息。
- -另外,師生同樂日、社際時事禁毒常識問答比賽、短片比賽等都有賴老師的參與及協助。因此老師對推廣健康校園 文化有極大的幫助。



Overall evaluation of the project

- 3. 透過紀律訓練,讓學生學懂堅持、自律、面對逆境,引誘時能作出自決、抗逆惡劣環境,從而培養無懼困難與挑戰的勇氣。加強獨立思考及分析能力,從而讓學生有足夠能力抗拒及遠離毒品的禍害。
- -參加過Drugs Zero活動的學生都認為健康生活樂趣無窮,透過學生禁毒工作坊、外展歷奇活動、獨木舟、攀石訓練等,他們的自信及抗逆力提升,並運用正確的方法面對毒品的誘惑(逆境)



Overall evaluation of the project

- 4. 讓非華語的學生能有更多與本地的學生接觸和 溝通的機會,使他們儘快融入社區,了解本土文 化,減低文化衝突,從而抗拒各種不良的誘惑。
- -16位學生(14非華語2華語)學生完成『Drugs Zero』舞蹈培訓計劃,並參與最少一次的Drugs Zero禁毒教育活動。參與舞蹈培訓的學生都在嘉年華中有舞蹈表演,他們表示非常珍惜那次表演機會,他們的自信心及對校園的歸屬感大大提升,亦有信心面對未來的挑戰。



Conclusion

- 學生透過參與各項活動,提高了對毒品禍害的認識,同時也可把毒品對人的禍害的訊息傳播給他人。
- 而在此計劃中,最重大的得益便是使一群 非華語的同學更認識抗毒的重要,同時更 可使華語及非華語的同學更能一起參與各 項活動,使非華語的同學能更快適應香港 的文化。
