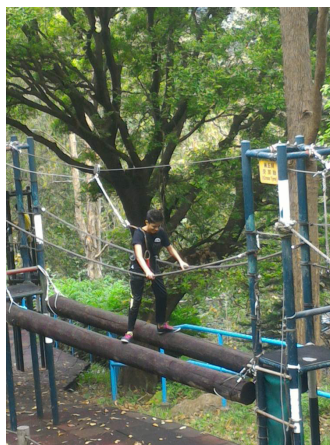

Experience Gained

- 少數族裔家長一般較難參與系列性工作坊，規劃活動時需審慎考慮
- 執行計劃時遇上困難，需考慮可行補救措施(如加開活動節數、向基金會申請延期等)
