









## Output and Outcome Evaluation

Out <sub>l</sub> Indica	25 drug dependent gay and lesbian youths receive counselling service, serving a total of 150 man-times	27 (108%) drug dependent gay and lesbian youths receive counselling service, serving a total of 187 (125%) man-times
Outy Indica	80 gay and lesbian youths attend support and education group (10 youths x 8 groups x 6 sessions = 480 mantimes)	95 (119%) gay and lesbian youths attend support and education group, serving a total of 506 (105%) man- times

Outcome Indicator 1	70% of drug dependent LGBT clients show improvement in their quitting motivation (or significant improvement as indicated by paired t-test)	25 valid case evaluated 76% of drug dependent LGBT clients show improvement in their quitting motivation			
Outcome Indicator 2	50% of the drug dependent LGBT clients reduce drug use after completion of treatment	25 valid cases evaluated, among which 22 cases indicated drug use in pre-test while 3 cases indicated no drug use in pre-test.  Among the 22 cases indicated drug use in pre-test, 77% reduce drug use after completion of treatment. For the 3 cases indicated no drug use in pre-test, 67% of them avoided relapse

Outcome Indicator 3	60% of drug dependent LGBT clients show improvement in their depressive symptoms (or significant improvement as indicated by paired t-test)	25 valid case evaluated 80% of drug dependent LGBT clients show improvement in their depressive symptoms			
Outcome Indicator 4	80% of participants increase their perceived risk associated with drug abuse (or significant improvement as indicated by paired t-test)	92 valid case evaluated 87% of participants increase their perceived risk associated with drug abuse

## **Experience Gained**

- Research finding indicates that the prevalence of ChemSex is alarming among gay men.
- There is an urgent need to develop a service model for gay men struggling with chemsex. Multidisciplinary collaboration among medical professionals, social workers and academia would facilitate formation of an appropriate treatment services catering the special needs of LGBT community
