- 4. Treatment on drug abusers
- 5. Rehabilitation on drug abusers
- 6. Psychosocial intervention on drug abusers










# **Tertiary level of training**

- ➤ The journal documented their encounter with drug abusers and their feelings and experience gained from the process









# Output and Outcome Evaluation


