Primary level of training

- **6 learning modules**
 1. Basic concepts of drug abuse
 2. Services for drug abusers in Hong Kong
 3. Screening, diagnosis and assessment on drug abusers
 4. Treatment on drug abusers
 5. Rehabilitation on drug abusers
 6. Psychosocial intervention on drug abusers

- Visits to voluntary drug treatment and rehabilitation centres

Tertiary level of training

- **Reflective journals**
 - each participant submitted a reflective journal after field visit
 - The journal documented their encounter with drug abusers and their feelings and experience gained from the process

- Tailor made evaluation questionnaire (pre-test and post-test)





Output Evaluation

	Expected Result	Achieved Result
Output Indicator 1	Recruit 300 participants, among which 70% complete the whole training	314 nursing students have been recruited and 285 nursing students have completed the whole training




Outcome Evaluation

	Expected Result	Achieved Result
Outcome Indicator 1	Significant improvement in student's ability to identify drug abusers in an early stage as indicated by paired t-test OR 70% of participants show improvement after training	89.6% of participants showed improvement after training

Outcome Evaluation

	Expected Result	Achieved Result
Outcome Indicator 2	Significant improvement in student's capacity to support drug abusers as indicated by paired t-test OR 70% of participants show improvement after training	95.7% of participants showed improvement after training





Conclusion

This project is effective in

- equipping participants with professional knowledge and skills related to drug abuse
- enhancing participants' awareness and vigilance on drug abuse problems
- strengthening participants' capacity in working with drug abusers.
