- Developed two VR simulation games and two VR minigames, which are unique, interactive and attractive role-playing game for the aim of anti-drugs education

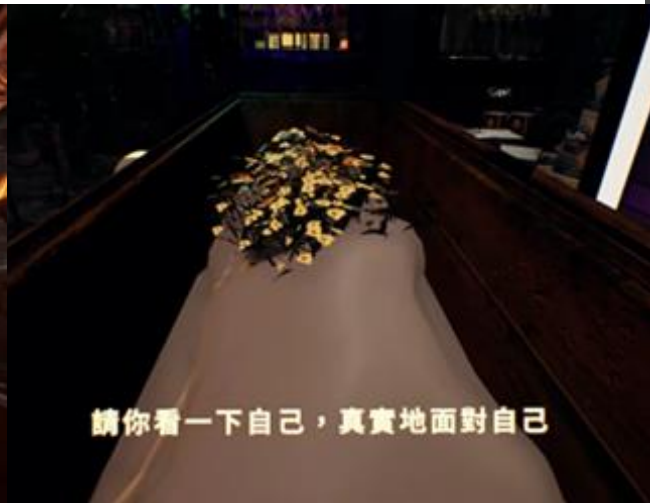

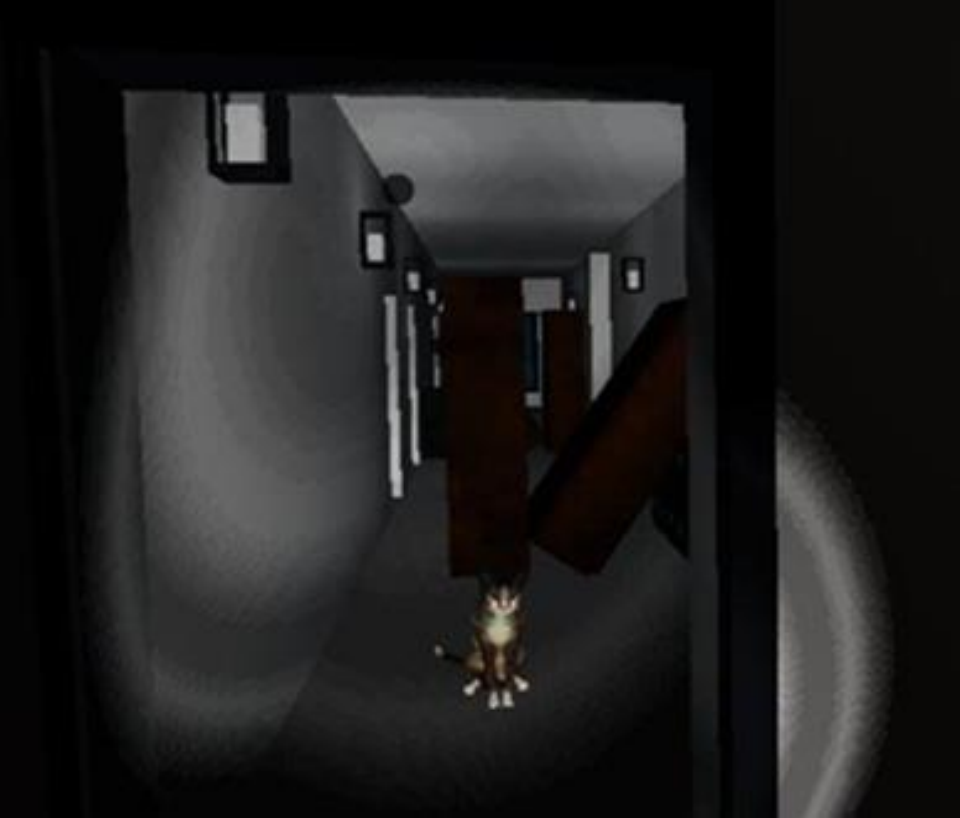
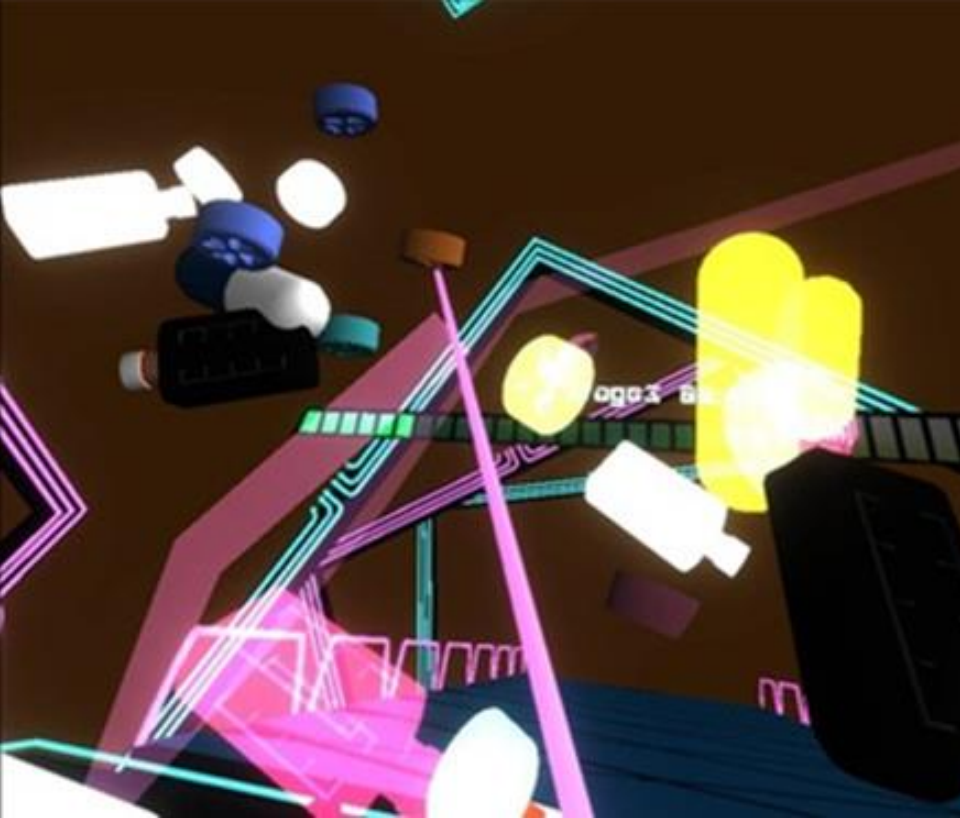

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# Sports in mid-night

- Provided sports training for youth-at-risk and drug abusers during mid-night
- Facilitated service users setting up personal goals with relative time-based



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# Mid-night station

- A drug-free venue for drug abusers located in Southern District
- Sports training and leisure activities including fitness training, boardgame and gaming, were held for drug abusers in mid-night station



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## Physical Rehabilitation Treatment

- Sports training and competitions were organized for drug abusers
- E.g. Football, basketball, frisbees, darts and fitness



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# Sports Ambassador (Anti-drug Team)

- Drug rehabilitees as sports ambassadors to promote anti-drug message online and identify hidden drug abusers
- Identity changed from help seeker to helper



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## Anti-drug activities in bar/schools

- Organized anti-drug activities such as darts competitions and anti-drug VR education in bars
- Provided anti-drug VR education and shared the harm of drugs abuse in schools

- drug abusers and hidden drug abusers



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# Output & Outcome evaluation



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# Output Evaluation

Output indicator 1	To provide 210 youth-at-risk and 90 drug abusers not less than 300 sessions of VR Drug Education	Provided 916 (305.3%) sessions for 823 (392%) youth-at-risk and 93 (103.3%) drug abusers
Output indicator 2	To provide 45 youth-at-risk and 45 drug abusers not less than 60 sessions of sports training and exercises	Provided 331 (551.6%) sessions of sports training and exercises for 52 youth-at-risk (115.5%) and 46 drug abusers (102.2%)
Output indicator 3	To provide not less than 40 team discussion for 8 sports ambassadors (drug rehabilitees)	Provided 48 (120%) team discussion for 14 (175%) sports ambassadors (drug rehabilitees)



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# Output Evaluation

Output indicator 4	To provide 72 drug abusers and hidden drug abusers not less than 57 sessions of medical assessment/ treatment services	Provided 176 (308.7%) sessions of medical assessment/treatment services for 103 drug abusers and hidden drug abusers (143%)
Output indicator 5	To provide 2,500 man times of youth-at-risk not less than 75 sessions of outreaching service	Provided 75 (100%) sessions of outreaching service for 3,379 (135%) man times of youth-at-risk



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# Outcome evaluation

Outcome indicator 1

70% of drug abusers and at-risk youths, who join the VR drug education program show improvement in their drug knowledge

83.1% of drug abusers and at-risk youths showed improvement in their drug knowledge

Outcome indicator 2

Participants of mid-night sports training show positive change in their anti-drug attitude

79.9% of participants show improvement in anti-drug attitude



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# Outcome evaluation

Outcome indicator 3

Drug abusers show positive change in their anti-drug attitude

75.8% of participants show improvement in anti-drug attitude

Outcome indicator 4

50% of hidden drug abusers receive face-to-face counseling/ interviews (or other face-to-face follow up services)

29 interviews were conducted.  
48.3% of hidden drug abusers receive face-to-face counseling/ interviews (or other face-to-face follow up services)

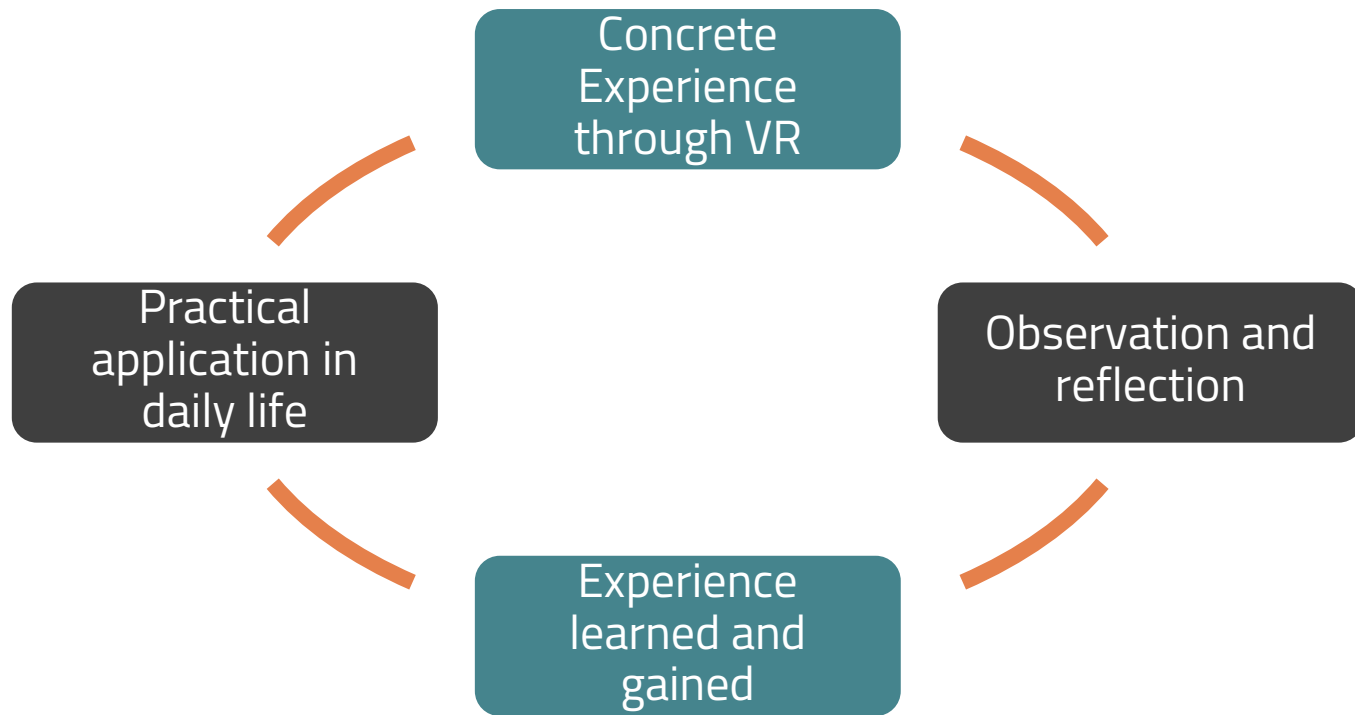
