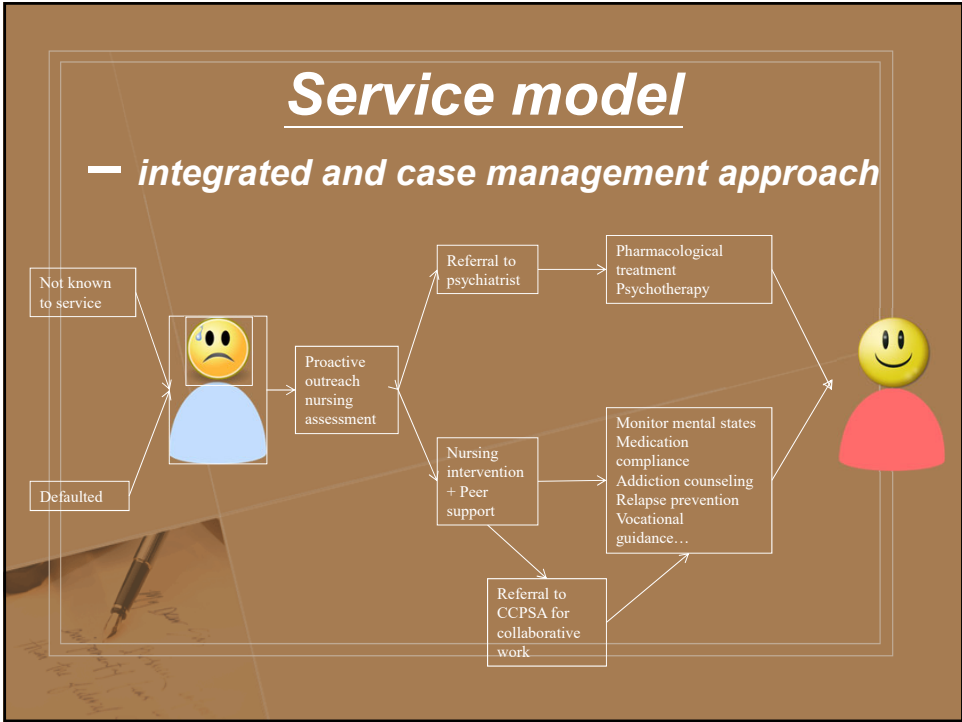

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Introduction

- A decrease of reported substance abusers was noted but an increased hidden years of substance abuse → increase risk of physical and mental health of substance abusers

 - Severe in distress
 - Need medication
 - Need intensive multidisciplinary service

Project Content – home visit

- Health
 - Monitor on condition
 - Medication adherence education
- Detox counseling
 - Motivational interviewing
 - Relapse prevention
- Social
 - Daytime activities
 - Vocational coaching

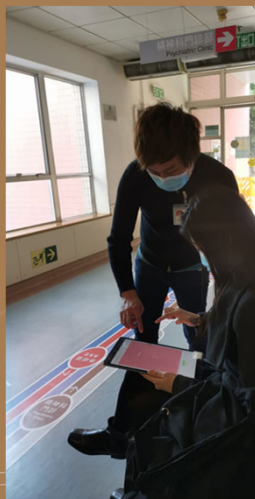
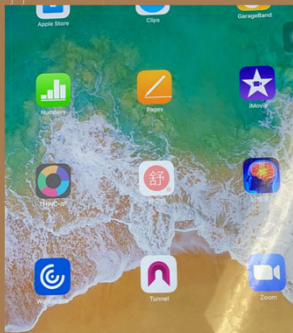
Project Content – carer support

 - Use of community resources

- Output: patient record
- Outcome:
 - BDF questionnaire 6, 13, 20
 - Validated questionnaire (BPRS, DASS21, CISS)
 - Referral form

Output Benchmarks & Evaluation Results

	Expected Result	Achieved Result
Assessment to substance abusers	150 substance abusers	154 substance abusers (102.6% of target)
Assessment to carers of substance abusers	75 carers of substance abusers	105 carers of substance abusers (140% of target)
Outreach service for substance abusers	900 outreach services for 150 substance abusers	1219 outreach services (135.4% of target) for 146 substance abusers (97.3% of target)
Outreach services for carers of substance abusers	450 outreach services for 75 carers of substance abusers	423 outreach services (94% of target) of 83 carers of substance abusers (110.7% of target)
Refer to CCPSA / ICCMW	45 referrals	42 referrals (93.3% of target)

Outcome Benchmarks & Evaluation Results

	Expected Result	Achieved Result
Reduction in frequency of substance abuse	70% of substance abusers	87.5%
Improvement in psychiatric co-morbidity	70% of substance abusers	85.8% (BPRS) 89.2% (DASS21)
Improvement in functional states	70% of substance abusers	84.2%
Improvement in readiness to quit drugs	70% of substance abusers	82.5%
Improvement in ability to take care of drug abusing family members	70% of carers of substance abusers	86.4%

Process Evaluation

- Start of COVID-19
 - A more flexible in visiting place and time
 - Strict infection control measures

Experience Gained

- Help for participants and carers
 - Improve in detox journey, job, mental health, family relationship
- Help for community
 - Increase collaboration among hospital and community

- The integrated and case management approach in this program help for the improvement of substance abuse and health problems of participants
- A close collaboration with community can be enhanced
