


Objectives


- Assist client to reduce or stop using illicit drugs
- Assist client to establish improvement in mental health and daily functioning
- Enhance client motivation to quit drugs



Major activities

- Provide professional and comprehensive assessment, screening, risk and problem identification
- Design and deliver individualized and tailor-made care program and treatment plan for substance abusers
- Facilitate inter-agency collaboration on handling substance abusers
- Enhance sustainability of detox among substance abusers and support to carers via peer counseling service
- Provide assessment, treatment and referral to carers of substance abusers whom with emotional challenges







Extended Supportive Service

Family interventices & Relationship Reconciliation

-Dealing with problematic communication pattern and fostering family support for SA patients to quit drugs

Community Liaison

-Referring community service and persistently collaborating with the stakeholders for the rehabilitation of patients and their family members ,such as CCPSA, ICCMW, DTRC, family service and elderly service


Detox Center Support

-Referring patient with chronic mental illness to receive long term detox treatment in DTRCs and persistently collaborating with the stakeholders to safeguard patient to adapt to detox hostel livelihood

Service Deliverables _ Output

Outcome indicator	Target	Output Achieved
Output indicator 1	To conduct comprehensive physical, psychosocial and spiritual assessment for 420 substance abusers	429 substance abusers are assessed (102% of target)
Output indicator 2	To provide 640 sessions of outreach individual counselling for 80 substance abusers	81 substance abusers are served (101% of target) and a total of 771 outreach individual counselling sessions are provided (120% of target)
Output indicator 3	To provide 320 sessions of outreach individual counselling for 80 carers of substance abusers	98 carers of substance abusers are served (123 % of target) and a total of 327 outreach individual counselling sessions are provided (102% of target)
Output indicator 4	To provide 72 group sessions for substance abusers / carers of substance abusers, with a total of 432 attendees

	Outcome indicator 1	70% of the participants shown improvement on readiness to quit drugs or statistical significant improvement in participant's stage of change	Statistical significant improvement found using paired t-test Target met
	Outcome indicator 2	70% of the participants shown improvement in mental state or statistical significant improvement in participant's mental state (outcome measures in BPRS/DASS21)	BPRS: 89.3% Statistical significant improvement found in DASS21 scale using paired t-test Target met
	Outcome indicator 3	70% of the participants shown improvement in functional state or statistical significant improvement in participant's functional state outcome measures in CISS)	95.2% <u>Target met</u>
V/	Outcome indicator 4	70% of the participants reduced substance use or stopped using drugs after completing the program	93.3% reduced drug use 70.2% quitted drugs 94.1% avoided relapse. <u>Target met</u>



Multi – disciplinary collaboration

- -Collaboration with Clinical Team, SWD and Stakeholder in community
- -Partnership with Peer specialist foster mutual trust between client and worker, and strengthen their motivation to

abstain substance

Timely intervention

- -Intervention is conducted at a timely manner during hospitalization
- -Service delivering from intoxication or relapse of mental illness to drug abstaining phase
- -Prompt referral of relevant service i.e.Gambling counseling service for family support, Elderly service, marital counseling, children care
